Organization and Administration  
of the  
INDIANA GUARD RESERVE

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**Summary.** This regulation establishes Joint Forces Headquarters Indiana policy regarding the interaction of the National Guard in the nature, status, organization, missions, and employment of State Defense Forces (SDF), as outlined in 32 U.S.C. 109. It outlines only that assistance that JFHQIN has been authorized to furnish to the Indiana Guard Reserve (IGR) in equipping, arming, and training the IGR under current law. It identifies The Adjutant General of Indiana as the Commander by authority of the Governor and the executive agent and channel of communications between JFHQIN and the IGR on all matters pertaining to the IGR.

**Applicability.** This regulation applies to the State Defense Force for Indiana, the Indiana Guard Reserve. This regulation addresses the subject of Organization, Mission and Administration for the IGR.

**Supplementation.** This regulation may not be supplemented by any subordinate Indiana Guard Reserve element.

**Mobilization Status.** During mobilization or national emergency, this regulation may be rescinded.
